

# **Spoonflowers (Pk/48)**

#### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Wooden Teardrop Shapes
- Cardboard Circles
- Markers
- Pinbacks
- Glue

AGE GROUP: 5 and up PREP TIME: 5 Minutes PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

#### YOU WILL NEED:

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. a) Take one of the cardboard circles and lay it down on your work surface with the white side facing down.
  - b) Apply an even amount of glue to the dark side of the circle.
  - c) Place the pointed ends of six wooden teardrop shapes over glued circle (see Figure A). Dashed lines on illustration indicate shapes beneath. Any number of wood teardrops can be used in a flower.
  - d) Apply glue to the dark side of another cardboard circle.
  - e) Carefully place this circle, white side up, over the pointed ends of glued teardrop shapes. Let dry for 25 minutes.
- 2. a) Decide how you will decorate your flower. You may use our ideas or create your own designs.
  - b) Using a pencil, lightly sketch a design on flower center and petals.
  - c) Color in the designs using markers.
  - d) Glue a pinback to the center of the backside of the flower.
