

- 1. Paint the plastic basket mold and let dry. 2 coats of paint may be needed for solid coverage.
- 2. Measure and cut 3, 4 yard pieces of jute per basket. Tie one end of a piece onto the bottom of one of the basket posts.
- 3. Weave the jute "in and out" of the posts. Thread beads onto the jute whenever you'd like (See Figure A).
- 4. As needed, tie a new piece of jute on, tuck the knot in the inside of the basket and continue weaving until basket is complete.

NOTE: You can push the jute down tightly on the basket posts to make a tighter basket or leave it loose depending on your personal preference. There is plenty of jute in the kit if you need it.

5. Tie the final end around one basket post and tuck the end back into the inside of the basket.
