

Teaching Activities Inside

TEACHER/PARENTAL INFORMATION

The best way to start this project is to learn about farm animals. There are many discussions that can be used to increase the students knowledge. There are many books written for children that cover this topic.

In this project, the child will create a pop-up book that will show six (6) farm animals. In making this book, the child will be using many skills needed for child development.

- Fine motor skills
- Sequencing
- Creative thinking

CHILD DISCUSSIONS

- Ask the children to name farm animals.
- How many farm animals have the children seen?
- What does each animal do on the farm?
- Has anyone been on a farm?
- Where are farms located?

Farm Animal Facts

The study and discussion of farm animals lets the children understand the farm function and the useful animals.

Farm Animals

- **Cows** are large animals that produce milk, which is very important to a healthy diet. Cows are usually brown, white or black in color. Cows eat grass.
- **Pigs** love to roll around in the mud. Pigs are grown to supply pork and bacon. Pigs eat meat and produce.
- **Sheep** give milk that cheese is made from. The most important thing that sheep are used for is to grow hair which is made into wool. Sheep eat grass and weeds.
- **Chickens** supply fresh eggs and are used as a source for very healthy food. Chickens eat bugs, grass, fruit and vegetables.
- **Goats** supply goats milk which is used for making cheese. Some people also eat goat meat. Goats eat most anything, including corn and grass.
- **Horses** are used for horseback riding. They help the farmer get from place to place and get work done. Horses eat grass and oats.
- **Farms** A farm is a place that raises animals and grows all our fresh food... potatoes, corn, fruit, and many other vegetables.

Pop-up Book Assembly

Your completed *Friendly Farm Animals* pop-up book will look similar to the one on the front page. You can change the look by using your own creativity.

Step # 1

Separate all the printed drawings from the sheets supplied. Be sure to keep them separated by subject... keep similar animals together. In addition, there is also a book cover of heavier paper as well as 6 popup individual pages.

Step # 2

Use the supplied crayons to decorate all the pieces, the cover and pages. You can use your own markers or colored pencils for decoration. Use your own creativity.

Step # 3

After decorating all the pieces you are ready to assemble your pop-up book.

The book has 6 pages. Each page has a place for 2 similar farm animals. Fold each page in half on the scored line. When doing this, "pop-up" the 2 places that have slits cut into the page (see Fig. 1). Glue each of the 2 farm animal pieces on each "pop-up" section. This page is now a "pop-up" page.

Step # 4

Continue "Step # 3" until all 6 pages are complete.

Step # 5

Using the glue provided, glue one page on top of the other. Be sure the pages are folded in half when gluing (see Fig 2). Your book is almost complete.

Step # 6

Fold the book cover following the scored lines in the center of the cover. Place glue on the back of the last page and glue it to the inside of the back cover. The last step is to now glue the first page to the inside of the front cover.

Your *Friendly Farm Animals* pop-up book is now complete. You should be extremely proud of your accomplishment!
