## How to Play

Choose the colour counters you want to play with and take turns slotting your counters into the frame.

To win, you must get 4 of your coloured counters in an uninterrupted row, column, or diagonal line. When you achieve this, you have won the game!

# Strategy

The aim is to block your opponent from forming a line, whilst at the same time, building up as many chances as possible for you to win yourself.

Think ahead - don't play each move in isolation. Think about placing your counters where they make potential winning lines for later.


The killer tactic is to create a double attack: create a potential winning row of 4 which your opponent has to block, but in doing so he creates another winning row for you.




# Assembly Instructions:




Step 1
Insert the counter stand (F) into the hole (Y) in the bottom leg section (D).



Step 2
Slot the bottom frame section (B) into the bottom leg sections (D) by inserting the tabs into the holes in the legs.




Step 3
Slot the top frame section (A) into the top leg sections (C) in the same way as in step 2.



Step 4

Slot the top leg sections (C) into the bottom leg sections (D) by slotting the round pegs (W) in the top leg sections into the holes (X) in the bottom leg sections.



Step 5
Finally, slide the 2 sliders (E) into the slots (Z) in the bottom legs.
