# Color-Me ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Plastic Kite 

## PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING

## PREP INSTRUCTIONS:

Unroll the kite. Set aside the sticks and the kite string.

1. Place the kite on your work surface so that the plastic pockets are facing down.
2. Plan a design and color with the permanent markers. Let dry.
3. To assemble the kite, turn the kite over.

The vertical support comes pre-installed with a X shaped connector about 3/4's of the way up. Be sure the $X$ shaped connector is positioned such that the open portions of the connector are angled upward. Insert a support stick through the hole in the plastic portion of the kite toward the outer edge and into the plastic fitting on the front side of the kite. Insert the opposite end of the support stick into the plastic connector on the vertical support. Repeat the same process with the second support stick.

4. Attach the kite string to the plastic ring on the string on the front side of the kite and you're ready to fly.

KITE SAFETY: Parental guidance is recommended when flown by children 8 years old and younger. Never fly a kite


CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Not for children under 3 years. near electric wires. Always be sure the cord on a kite is dry. Electricity can pass through wire, wet cord, or cord with metal on it.
