



- 1. Remove any dirt, dust or oil from the metal coasters so the grout will set properly. You can do this with glass cleaner and a paper towel or just wash them with dish soap and hot water.
- 2. Mix grout using plastic bowl and spoon. Add enough water to the grout powder to make a smooth thick paste, free from lumps. Let stand 15 minutes and remix before using. **NOTE:** Mix <u>only</u> the amount of grout that can be used in one hour. Mix additional batches as needed, you will have extra grout powder.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Trace the circle coaster shape onto scrap paper and lay your tile design out on the paper so you don't have to move the tile again.
- 2. Using the plastic spoons, spoon enough grout into the metal coasters until they are approx. ¾ of the way full.
- **TIP:** Don't overfill the coaster base, as the grout will spill over the top when you press your tiles into place.
- 3. Press your tiles into the wet grout following your design.
- 4. Once all your tiles are in place put your coaster aside to set for at least 12 hours or until the grout is hard and completely dry.
