PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes + dry time

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- lars
- Simulated Lead
- Permanent Markers

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scrap Paper
- Pencils

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

A jar with lid

The simulated lead and markers will be shared among the group.

PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Decide what kind of design you would like to have on the jar. You may use one of our designs or create your own.

TIP: While painting the jar's surface, try to handle only the inside neck of the jar.

- 2. Sketch your design outline using the scrap paper and pencils.
- 3. a. Practice drawing a few lines using the simulated lead. Hold the bottle nozzle 1/4" above a piece of paper and move hand in a smooth motion. Be sure your wrist is not resting on work surface as you move your hand.
 - b. When you feel you have practiced the technique enough, begin to draw your pattern on the jar.
 - c. Set jar aside to dry.
- 4. a. Fill in sections of simulated lead outlines using the permanent markers. Be sure the marker goes up against the lead outlines so no empty spaces show.
 - b. For more intense colors, apply another coat when the first coat is completely dry.
