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# Aloha Mobile (Pk/12)

- Foam Flowers
- Straw Beads
- Wood Dowels
- Red Cord


AGE GROUP: 4 and up PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

#### YOU WILL NEED:

Clear Work Surface

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Lay all materials out on clean work surface.
- 2. Cut 3 pieces of yarn at different lengths to start your mobile.
- 3. Attach one piece of cord to the end of a wood dowel (approx 2 inches from the edge) by wrapping it around and tying a tight knot. Be sure to leave approx 3 inches on one end and the remainder of the yarn on the other. See Figure A
- 4. Repeat Step 2 at the opposite end of the craft stick.
- 5. Pull the two 3 inch pieces up and tie a knot to hold them together. This will be the hanger for your completed mobile.
- 6. Attach a 3rd piece of yard in the middle of the stick, without leaving any excess on one end.
- 7. **TIP:** Hold the mobile up by the 'hanger' to imagine how it will hang. Be sure the long yarn pieces are hanging down and are not twisted on the stick.
- 8. Begin attaching the foam flowers to the first string. Thread a straw piece onto the string, then a flower, then another straw piece. Repeat several times, leaving a straw piece as the last item.
- 9. Take the remaining yarn and rethread it back up into the last flower and pull through. Maneuver the bottom straw piece to be parallel and snug to the bottom of the flower. Holding this in place, tie the yarn in a knot right above the last flower. Any excess yarn can be trimmed and threaded back into the adjacent straw piece to conceal it.
- 10. Repeat Step 7 and 8 with the 2 remaining lengths of cord.



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
