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

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Plastic Baskets
- Yarn
- Paint
- Brushes

AGE GROUP: 8 and up PROJECT TIME: 60 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Container for Water
- Paper Towels

INSTRUCTIONS:

Each basket will have a different look, due to the shading of the yarn colors. Each basket takes approximately 10 yards of yarn. If working with a large group, it may be beneficial to pre cut the yarn in 10 yard lengths.

- 1. Paint the plastic baskets with the blue paint and allow to dry.
- 2. Start the weaving with one end of yarn at the bottom of the basket. You could scotch tape the yarn on the bottom of the basket temporarily to hold it steady while weaving a few rows.
- 3. Go in and out of every post on the basket. Since there are an odd number of posts, this will cause an alternating weave pattern to occur. That way you can tell if you are weaving correctly: One row will be a yarn on the outside of a certain post and the next round the yarn will be on the inside of that same post.
- 4. When you reach the top, weave the ends of the yarn into some previous rows to hide the ends.

Helpful Hint: The yarn does not need to be pulled tight on every row. The important thing is to keep a consistent tension on the yarn so that the basket looks even.
