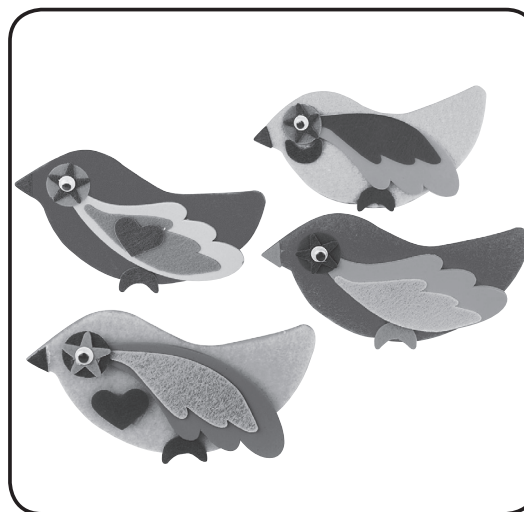

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Self Adhesive Foam Birds
- Neon Felt Sheets
- Assorted Felt Shapes
- Self Adhesive Felt/Foam Wings
- Paper Clips
- Wiggly Eyes
- Glue

YOU WILL NEED:

- Quality Scissors

AGE GROUP: 8 and up
PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 1 Self Adhesive Foam bird
- 1 Felt Rectangle
- 3-4 Assorted Felt Shapes
- 1 Wiggle Eye
- 2 Paper Clips
- 1 Self Adhesive Large Foam Wing
- 1 Self Adhesive Small Felt Wing – Make sure the two wings you choose are cut in the same direction.
- The glue and scissors will be shared among the group.

PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:

It helps to fold and cut the felt sheets ahead of time into 8 equal pieces. Everyone will need one felt rectangle in the color of their choice. The more variety of color used to assemble the birds, the more interesting the finished project will be!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take the two paper clips and gently pull them open into a 90 degree angle. These will be used to the bird's feet, so it stands up.
2. Remove the paper backing off the foam bird and lay down on your work surface sticky side up! Stick the 2 paper clips (the larger "U" sides) side-by-side down to the bottom center area of the sticky foam bird. The two smaller "U" shapes should be sticking out towards you.
3. Next, sandwich the paper clips between the foam bird and the felt rectangle. Carefully press the felt rectangle over the bird with the paper clips stuck in place, making sure to cover all the edges of the bird.
4. Next pick up the bird and cut the excess felt off following the edge of the foam bird shape. Now your bird should stand up!
5. Take the small felt wing and remove the paper backing and stick it to the top of the larger foam wing making sure they are facing the same direction. This layer should give your bird wings some nice dimension.
6. Next remove the paper backing from the large foam wing and stick the wings in place. See the finished sample image as a reference for placement.
7. Use the glue, assorted felt shapes and wiggly eye to finish creating your birds' friendly features! **TIP:** You can cut the rounded sides off the felt heart shapes to make a perfect beak for your bird. Get creative and have fun. Allow glue to dry and you're done. Great Job!
