YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Sensory Tubes & Lids
- Glitter
- Assorted Shells
- Fish Beads
- Sequins
- Liquid Watercolor
- Window Cling Paint

YOU WILL NEED:

- Water
- Paint Pipette
(Item # AC737)
- Paper Towels
- E6000 Glue or Non-Water Soluble Strong Glue (Optional)

AGE GROUP: 8 and up
PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 1 Sensory Tube
- 6 Shells
- 6 Sequins
- 6 Fish Beads

The glitter, liquid watercolor and window cling paint will be shared among the group.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove the screw top lid from your sensory tube and set aside.
2. Place the shells, sequins and fish beads (approx. 6 of each) into your empty tube.
3. Add in a few shakes of glitter and 1 to 2 drops of the blue liquid watercolor using a paint pipette.
4. Carefully fill the tube to the top with water.
5. To prevent leaks, squeeze a line of strong glue around the inside rim of the screw top. (optional)
6. Screw the top on tightly. Wipe off any excess glue and allow time for drying.
7. Turn your sensory tube upside down so that the lid top is resting flat on the table.
8. Carefully use the window cling paint squeeze tube to draw seaweed lines up the outside of the tube to the curved top. Allow paint to dry.

MORE IDEAS...

1. For a slower moving snow globe, try using mineral oil instead of water as the liquid. But remember that the blue watercolor paint will not dissolve in mineral water, so the appearance would be clear water instead of blue.



2. Make different themes. Instead of using the blue coloring, leave the water clear and add trinkets to make any one of these theme ideas:

Valentine hearts, red plastic beads and sequins
 Spring flowers, using small silk flowers
 Sports equipment and a small banner decorated on the outside
 Patriotic, using small plastic flags, red, white and blue sequins, beads
 Fall leaves, sequins and pumpkin beads
 Christmas beads and sequins
 Snowflake sequins, blue water, snowflake beads, white glitter



3. Window cling paints can be purchased in many colors to decorate the outside of the jar in any theme or style. (Item # PT3322)
