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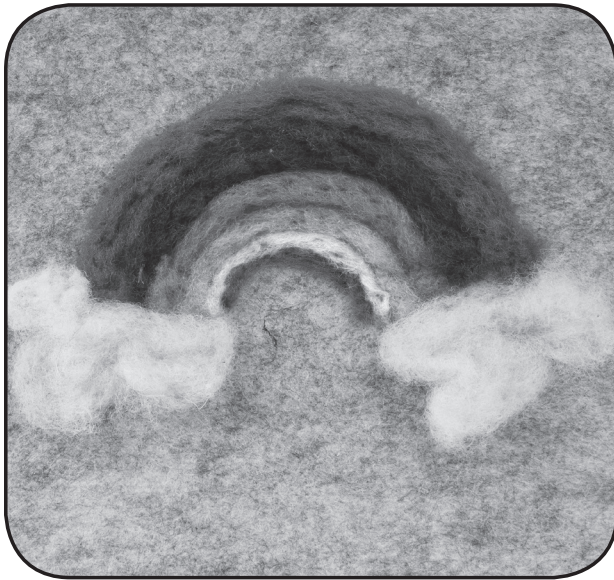
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MAKING IT EASY
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Wool Needle Felting Craft Kit (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Assorted Color Wool Roving
- Barbed Needles
- Foam Pads
- Wood Sticks
- Wool Squares

YOU WILL NEED:

- A flat work surface

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 1 Foam Square
- 1 Wool Square
- 1 Barbed Needle
- 1 Wood Stick

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Kit may contain silicone gel packets, which should be removed before use.

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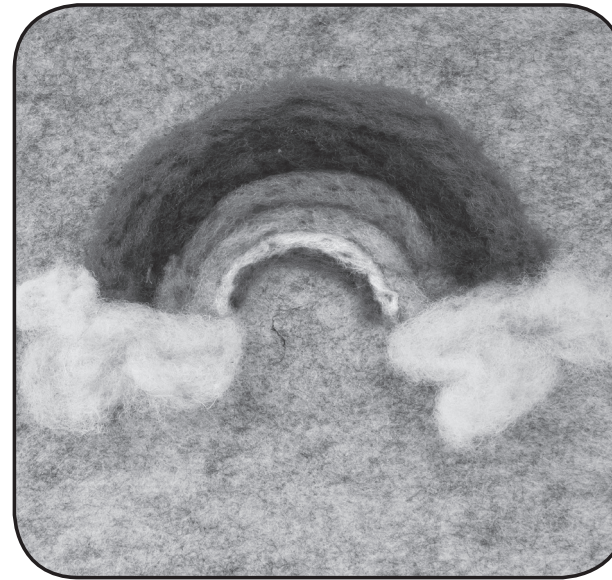
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PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The wool roving will be shared among the group.

Needle felting is easy to do! Simply poke colorful roving wool into the wool canvas to create a picture! This kit is a perfect introduction to the art of needle felting. It allows you to experiment with the sculptural characteristic of wool roving. The needles contain several barbs on the lower part and are very sharp so use caution! The barbs grab the wool fiber from the roving wool and the felted canvas and fuse them together.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. It is best to decide what your design will be first. Simple ideas include a flower, a pattern (chevron, polka dots etc), a rainbow, an animal.
2. Place a foam pad on a flat work surface.
3. Select a color of roving wool that you'd like to start with. You can roll and shape it a little if you want.
4. Place the piece of roving wool on your wool square and begin poking it into the shape you want. Remember to poke straight up and down with the needle.
5. Use one hand and hold the wood stick to push and hold the roving wool in place while you are poking it in with the needle.
6. Repeat steps 2-4 adding other colors of roving wool to your design until it is complete.
7. Carefully remove the wool square from the foam pad when done.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS:

Work in a small area at a time on the wool square.

Place a small amount of roving wool on top of the wool square and simply begin poking in it with the needle. It is important to poke straight up and down.

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
