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
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Scratch-Artist Garland (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Round Foam Pieces
- Ribbon
- Scratch-Artist Circles
- Sticky Back Round Foam Frames
- Double-sided Tape Pieces
- Markers
- Wood Tool

AGE GROUP: 6 and up
PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 4 each of the Round Foam Pieces and the Sticky Back Round Foam Frames in the colors of his/her choice
- 4 each of the Scratch-Artist Circles and Double-sided Tape Pieces
- 1 Length of Ribbon
- 1 Wood Tool

INSTRUCTOR NOTE:

To modify this project for a larger group: The project instructions are designed to have 12 people each make a garland with 4 layered scratch art circles. However, if you have a larger group you can modify this so that each person has 1 or more circles, depending on the size of your group. The ribbon pieces can be tied together to make 1 longer garland. This can be a great class project!

NOTE: It is best to determine what design or word will go on the Scratch-Artist circles before beginning to scratch the design. Some word suggestions include: Hope, Love, Epic, Sing, Care, Jump, Grow and Look. You could also suggest some 3-letter words and use the extra circle for a scratch art picture or symbol.


INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Look at the colors of your large foam circles and decide what order you want them to be in for your finished garland.

NOTE: Make sure the large foam circles have the 2 holes at the top (later you will thread the ribbon through those holes to hang your garland).

2. Determine what word or design you will scratch into your circles.
3. Use the wood tool to carefully scratch the letters of your words or design in to the 4 circles.
4. Peel 1 of paper off 1 side of each of the 4 pieces of double-sided tape. Press 1 piece on the back of each Scratch-Artist circle.
5. Peel off the other piece of paper of the double-sided tape and then press each Scratch-Artist circle, in order, on your large foam circles.

6. Next peel off the paper on the sticky foam frames and carefully place 1 each over each Scratch-Artist circle (See Figure A).
7. Decorate the round foam pieces with the markers however you want!
8. Finally, thread the ribbon through the holes at the top of each circle.
