**YOUR KIT CONTAINS:**

- Sparkle Chenille Stems
- Plastic Tubes
- Mini Pony Beads
- Foam Balls
- Jumbo Craft Sticks
- Paint
- Brushes
- Wiggly Eyes
- Glue
- Self-Adhesive Foam Sheet

**YOU WILL NEED:**

- Cups of Water
- Paper Towels
- Scissors

**PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Pre-cut all the silver chenille stems in half, so you end up with 24 pieces, each 6 inches in length.
2. Cut the clear tubes into quarters.
3. The foam sheet can be cut up into small 1" x 3/4" strips.

**AGE GROUP: 10 and up**  
**PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes**

**EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:**

- 2 Sparkle Chenille Stems (of the same color)
- 2 Wiggly Eyes
- 1/2 of a Silver Chenille Stem
- 1 Foam Ball
- 1 Foam Strip
- 5 Mini Pony Beads
- 2 Plastic Tubes
- 1 Jumbo Craft Stick

The Paint and Glue will be shared among the group.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Take your 2 chenille stems and twist them together in an "X" shape. Make sure you twist them around in full rotation couple times so they are secure (see Fig. A).
2. Twist the two top stems together right at the center of the "X", then bend the stems down to either side so you can attach the foam ball/ninja's head (see Fig. B).
3. The small twist you just created with the top two stems is what you glue the foam ball to (see Fig. C). Push the chenille stems carefully into the ball about half way, remove it briefly to squeeze a dab of glue into the hole then replace to dry.
4. Hold the two bottom stems together and slide a pony bead over them both and up to the center of the "X" (see Fig. D).
5. With the two stems on the bottom of the "X" now separated, slide 1 tube piece (each 6" tube should be cut into 4 equal lengths) onto a chenille stem. Slide on a bead and then another tube piece. Repeat on the other leg/side. Fold the excess chenille stem at each end over onto itself so you're left with a 'foot' approx. 3/4" long or the same width of the craft stick (see Fig. E).
6. Repeat this same "tube-bead-tube" pattern on the upper two stems to create arms.
7. Twist the silver chenille stem into a simple cross shape to create your ninja's sword (see Fig. F). Crimp one of the ninja's hands over the handle of the sword to hold it in place.
8. Paint one side of your craft stick as desired and let dry. Remove the paper backing and use the tiny piece of sticky foam like tape to hold one of your ninja's feet to the center of your craft stick as a base (see Fig. G).
9. Paint the foam ball/head and glue the eyes in place (see image of finished sample for placement). Allow time for the glue to dry and your ninja is ready for battle! (see Fig. H)

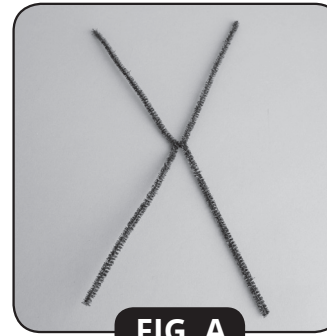

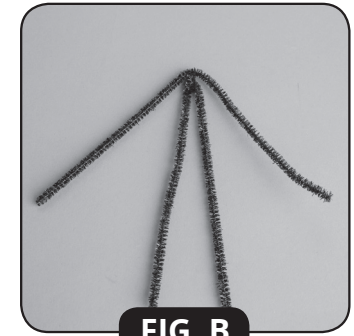

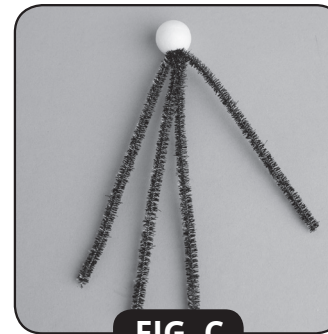

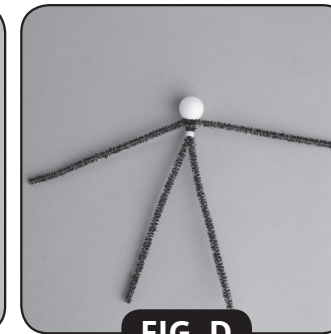

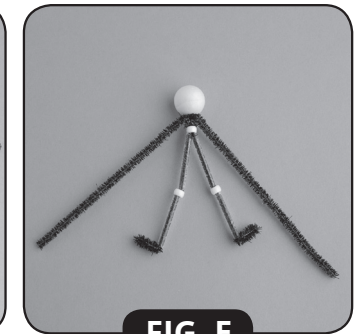

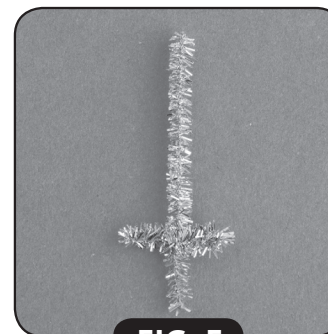

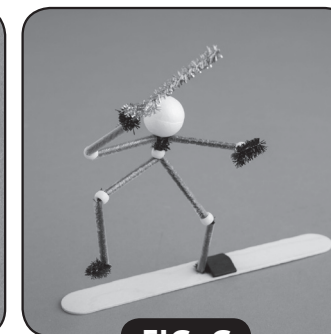
