Beaded Cross Pendants (Pk/12)

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Glow-in-the-Dark Heart Beads
- Glow-in-the-Dark Pony Beads
- Assorted Neon Heart Beads
- Assorted Neon Pony Beads
- Black Cord

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Ruler

AGE GROUP: 7 and up

PREP TIME: 1 minute

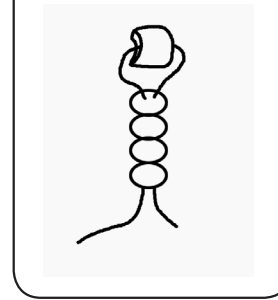
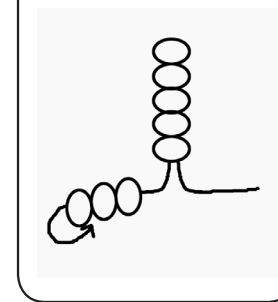
PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS:

Measure and cut black cord into a one yard length.

1. Select the beads you would like to use on your cross. You will need 14 beads. You may wish to plan out a pattern which sequences the different beads or different colors in a specific way.
2. Fold the entire lacing length exactly in half. String on one bead and center it.
3. Now bring both sides of the cord together and hold them as though they were one cord. Thread on 4 beads (see Figure A).
4. Separate the cord into two again. On the right side, string on 3 beads. Pull the cord through the end bead and thread it back through the second and first. Repeat this step on the left cord. Be sure that cord is pulled tightly so that beads touch (see Figure B).
5. Bring both sides of lacing together. Holding the cords as one, thread on 3 beads. Tie an overhand knot close to last bead (see Figure C).
6. Adjust pendant to fit your neck. Tie ends together securely and trim any rough edges.

NOTE: To recharge the glow-in-the-dark beads, place them under a lamp for a few minutes.
