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## Collage Container (Pk/48)

### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Cardboard Tubes
- Cardboard Circles
- Tissue Strips
- Glitter Glaze
- Decoupage Glaze
- Brushes

**AGE GROUP: 7 and up**  
**PREP TIME: 5 Minutes**  
**PROJECT TIME: 60 minutes**

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Container for Water
- Paper Towels
- Scissors

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Plan what kind of design you would like to create.
2. Brush a thin coat of decoupage medium on the outside of the cardboard tube. This acts as your glue as well as a sealer with a shiny finish when dry.
3. While it is still wet, start laying full strips of tissue paper onto the surface. You may apply tissue strips in a diagonal, horizontal or vertical direction on the tube.
4. Flatten out any creases, carefully smoothing with fingers.
5. Leave at least an inch hanging over the top and bottom of the tube.
6. Paint some decoupage medium on the inside rim of the top and bottom of the tube.
7. Crease down the excess tissue into the tube.
8. Cut tissue paper into abstract shapes. This is to decorate the collage containers on top of the strips.
9. Apply a small amount of decoupage medium to the cut shapes or directly onto the tube and stick the shapes on top of the strips applied in step 3.
10. Let the tissue strips and shape overlays dry.
11. Brush on the glitter glaze for accents on the collage container. Let dry.

**Helpful Hint:** If you are in a hurry you can use a hair dryer on a low speed to help speed up the drying process.

12. Brush a finishing coat of decoupage medium over the entire tube and the bottom edge.
13. Take one cardboard circle and press it onto the bottom edge. Make sure to line up the edge of the tube to the edge of the circle as closely as you can. Let dry.

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
