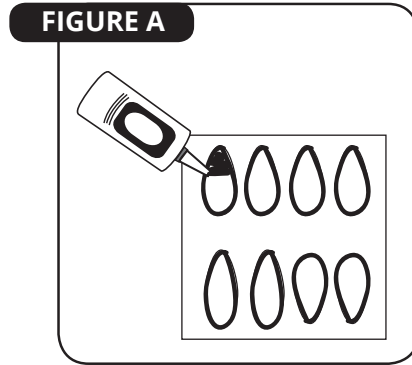
YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Paper Towels

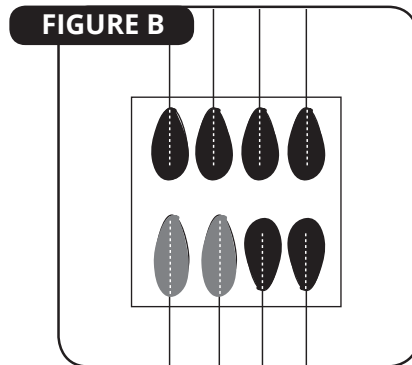
PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: Use your work surface as the drying area, so that you do not have to move the wet leaves.

1. Place one sheet of plastic on your work surface. Using the sticker paint, paint outline up to eight petals and leaves (refer to project patterns) on the plastic. Fill in the outlines with paint (see Figure A). Apply the paint approximately an 1/8 of an inch thick.



2. Select 4 pieces of floral wire and cut them in half. Place the wires into the petals and leaves embedding the wire in the paint while the paint is wet. Make sure the paint completely covers the end of the wire (see Figure B). Let the petals and leaves dry undisturbed until they are translucent. This could take up to 48 hours in humid weather.



3. Adult help may be needed. When the leaves and petals are completely dry, start to peel petals and leaves from plastic sheet. Don't start the peeling process from the wires as you might pull the wire out of the petal.

- Gather the petals into an arrangement and twist the wires together.
- Starting at the top of the stem wrap a piece of floral tape around the twisted wires pulling the tape tight as you wrap. Wrap the twisted wires with tape creating one stem, adding leaves as desired.
- Bend the petals and leaves to make the flower more natural.

PROJECT PATTERNS:

Optional: Place the patterns under the vinyl and trace the shapes with paint.
