

S&S Worldwide Cage Balls Inflation Instructions
W2371 – 24”, W2413 – 30”, W2370 – 36”, W2371 – 48” (4’)

Note: Cage ball bladders are designed to expand significantly in size as they are inflated. The bladder that came with your cage ball may not look large enough to fill the outer fabric cover, but the thick and pliable bladder will easily expand to fill your cage ball without popping!

Inflation Pump: To inflate these replacement bladders you will need a high volume inflator. These types of pumps are often used to inflate beach balls, exercise balls and other large inflatable items. Our Magic Air inflators like W5970, W2407 and W10698 will work well for these bladders. High pressure pumps like those used for sports balls are not recommended for bladders larger than 24” in diameter. The volume of air that the high pressure pumps, like our W9997, W3509 pumps, expel is too small and those pumps would need to run for an excessive amount of time possibly leading to overheating or failure of the pump. The pressure of the air put out by those types of pumps could also result in over inflation and possible explosion of the bladders.
