

Weaving Loom Kit

POT HOLDER:

Materials:

Loops
Loop Hook

STEP 1:

Take your loops and decide what color pattern you want to use. Stretch loops from the left side to the right side. Fill all pegs. FIGURE A

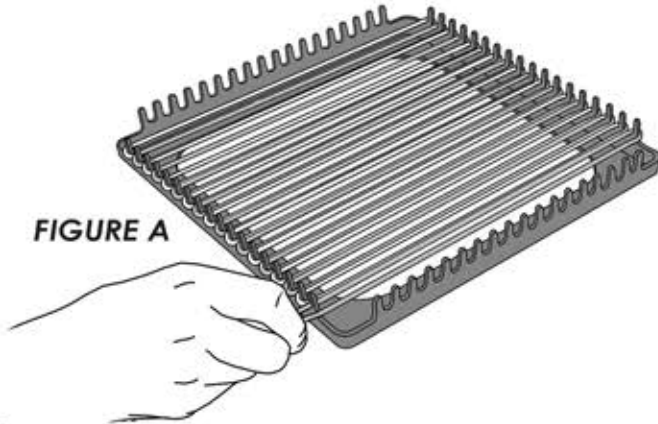

STEP 2:

Weave hook through stretched loops as shown in FIGURE B. Make sure to weave under one loop and over the next loop until you reach the other side. Hook on loop and pull hook through stretched loops FIGURE C.

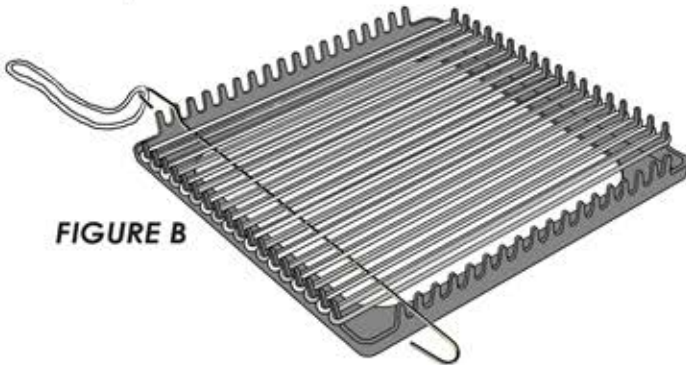

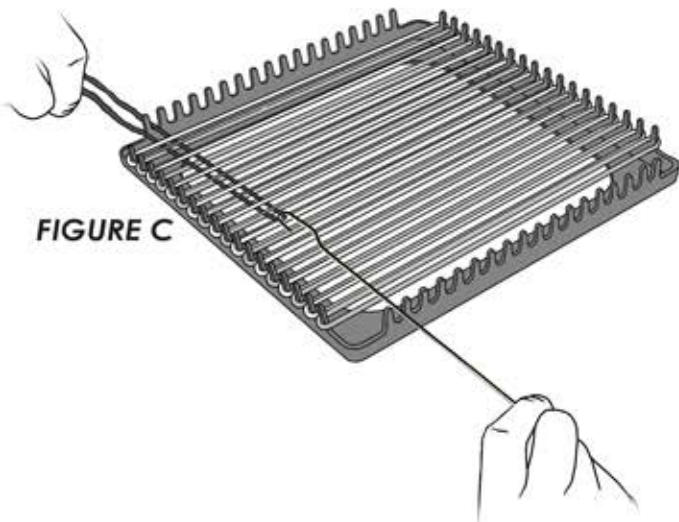

STEP 3:

Hook loop onto loom at both ends FIGURE D. Repeat steps 1 thru 4 until entire frame is full. Make sure that every other loop alternates under and over to create a weave. FIGURE E.

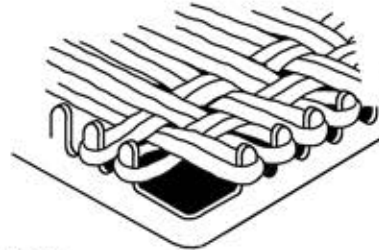
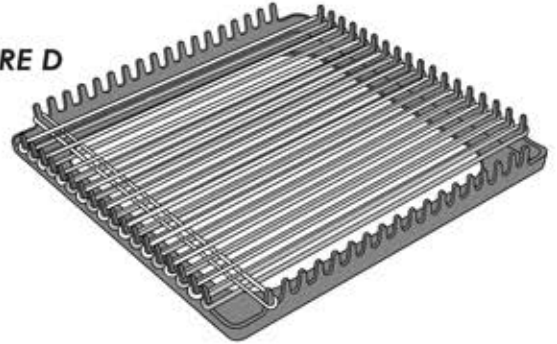

STEP 4:

Complete the edges by beginning at a corner and inserting the loop next to it through the hole. See FIGURE F. Continue around the entire loom. The last loop is for hanging the finished potholder. See FIGURE G

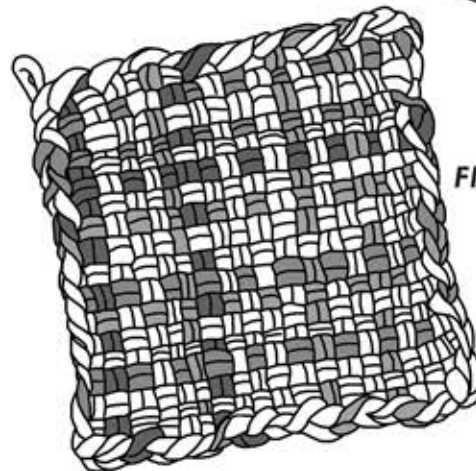
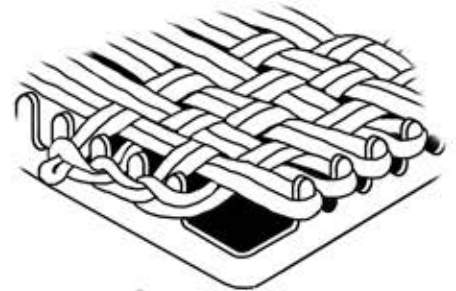
