INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Roll the pom pom between your hands making an oval shape, and then use your thumb to flatten out the bottom edge. Stick this bottom edge directly to the self-adhesive side of the orange heart (remove the paper backing) to create feet/standing base for your penguin.
2. Remove the paper backing and attach the two black foam wings on either side of the penguin. Stick on the white felt oval as the penguin's belly, centering it on the pom pom body above the orange foam feet. See finished image.
3. Continue to remove the paper backing and attach the bow, beak and eyes. You can gently tug the top of the pom pom up to create hair on your penguin's head. To make a boy penguin, position the bow on the "neck" of the penguin (like a bow-tie). For a girl penguin, position the bow in the "hair." Or use the bow however you'd like!
