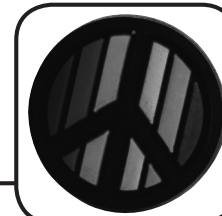

Rainbow Peace Sign Bracelet (Pk/24)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Rainbow Peace Sign Charms
- 2 Spools Tie Dye Cord
- Black Buckle Clasps

YOU WILL NEED:

- Ruler
- Scissors
- Tacky Glue
- Masking Tape

AGE GROUP: 8 and up
PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 1, 8' piece of Tie Dye Cord
- 1 Rainbow Peace Sign Charm
- 1 set of Black Buckle Clasps

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Measure and cut a piece of cord 8 feet long.
2. Fold the cord in half to find the center. Feed the center through the first half of the clip and pull the strands through the center as shown (see Figure A). If it is difficult to thread the center fold into the clip, then try to thread one end at a time and pull the cord until centered on the clip. Pull the working ends through the loop and pull down tight.
3. Slide on the peace charm (see Figure A). Feed the ends of the cord through the second half of the clip as shown (see Figure A). Slide the clip down the cord so that it is held 6 to 6.5 inches away from the first clip. Adjust to your wrist size as needed (see Figure B).
4. Make square knots (see Figures C, D, E and F). Square knot 1/2 way. Pass the working ends around either side of the peace charm. Continue to square knot until you reach the end.
5. Trim the remaining cord to leave only about 1/8 inch away from the last knot. Tuck cord ends into the underside of your bracelet.
6. Apply glue to the knot, especially at the base of the last knot created and to the end of the cord. Allow to dry.
