EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 2 Gold Glitter Circles
- 3 Strands each of Red, White and Blue yarn (9 total)
- Red foam letters that spell "USA"

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove the paper backing from one gold circle and place down on your work surface sticky side up. Remove the paper backing from the other gold circle and carefully stick the two together lining up the edges and the two holes.
2. Remove the paper backing from the foam letters and stick them to one side of your gold circle so they read "USA".
3. Keep the yarn in small bunches of the three strands each separated by color. Match up the ends of all 9 strands and knot them together at one end. Tape this end down to your work surface to make braiding easier. If you're working with young children you can have them simply twist the yarn together or knot the strands into simple patterns. (See finished shot for reference.)
4. When you braid the yarn, keep the three strand bunches working as one thick strand. So you have a thick strand of red white and blue. Braid until you reach the halfway point then thread on the gold medallion. Tip: Tape the ends of the yarn together tightly so you can easily pass them through the hole at once. Continue braiding until you reach the end.
5. Knot the two ends together to complete your necklace and you're done! Go For The Gold!

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 2 Gold Glitter Circles
- 3 Strands each of Red, White and Blue yarn (9 total)
- Red foam letters that spell "USA"

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove the paper backing from one gold circle and place down on your work surface sticky side up. Remove the paper backing from the other gold circle and carefully stick the two together lining up the edges and the two holes.
2. Remove the paper backing from the foam letters and stick them to one side of your gold circle so they read "USA".
3. Keep the yarn in small bunches of the three strands each separated by color. Match up the ends of all 9 strands and knot them together at one end. Tape this end down to your work surface to make braiding easier. If you're working with young children you can have them simply twist the yarn together or knot the strands into simple patterns. (See finished shot for reference.)
4. When you braid the yarn, keep the three strand bunches working as one thick strand. So you have a thick strand of red white and blue. Braid until you reach the halfway point then thread on the gold medallion. Tip: Tape the ends of the yarn together tightly so you can easily pass them through the hole at once. Continue braiding until you reach the end.
5. Knot the two ends together to complete your necklace and you're done! Go For The Gold!
