INSTRUCTIONS:

2. Start with the body. Glue two of the 2 large shapes together, being careful to match up the outside edges. Refer to Figure 1 as a guide and glue on 2 claws and 2 feet on top of the 2 layers of body.
3. Glue the 3rd crab body on top of the claws/"feet" layer. Glue on the 2 remaining claws making sure the edges line up with the other claws.
4. Glue on the wiggly eyes.
