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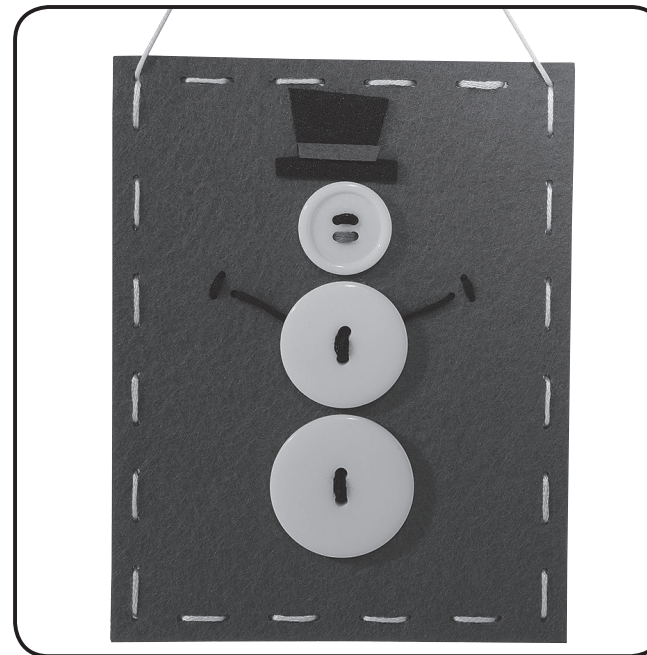
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Snowman Banner (Pk/12)

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Felt Banner Pieces (top and bottom)
- Floss and Plastic Needle
- Buttons
- Cord (for hanging)
- Felt Hat Pieces

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Ruler

AGE GROUP: 7 and up
PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes

EACH PERSON SHOULD HAVE:

- 1 set felt banner pieces
- 1- 20" piece white floss
- 1 length cord
- 1 felt hat and band
- 1- 6" piece red floss
- 1 each of small, medium, large buttons
- 1- 9" piece black floss
- 1 plastic needle

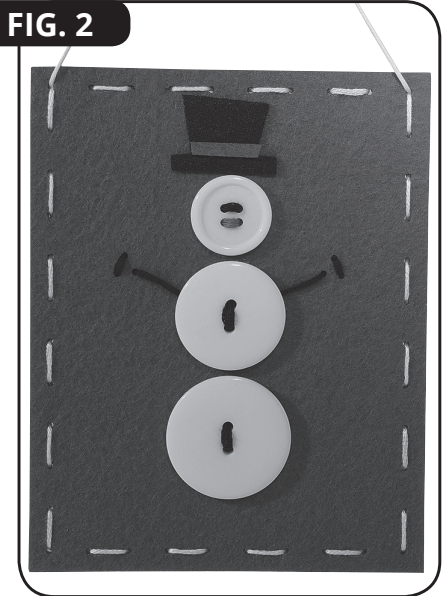
INSTRUCTIONS:**SEWING THE BUTTONS TO THE FRONT OF THE BANNER**

1. Thread your needle with the black floss and tie a knot in 1 of the strands, leaving the other loose (See Figure 1).
2. Take 1 of the large buttons and position over the 2 lowest holes on the banner. Sew button on using an over-under stitch. Tie a knot in the back of the banner and cut off floss.
3. Tie a new knot at the end of 1 strand of floss and repeat Step 2 with the other large button, sewing it above the other one.
4. Tie a new knot at the end of 1 strand of floss and position the small button at the top of the 2 other buttons and sew through the top 2 holes using the black floss. Stitch the arms/hands of the snowman (refer to Figure 2). Tie a knot in the back of the banner and cut off the floss.
5. Change your floss to red. Tie a knot at the end of 1 strand of floss and sew through the bottom 2 holes of the button.

SEWING THE BANNER PIECES TOGETHER

6. Change your floss to white, tie a knot at the end of 1 strand and position the front and back banner pieces together so the holes line up.
7. Sew the 2 banner pieces together using an over-under stitch sewing all around the banner. Tie a knot in the back of the banner and cut off the floss (See Figure 2).

8. Take the cord for hanging and thread 1 end through the top left corner hole and tie a knot. Repeat this step on the right side as well.
9. Glue the hat pieces on your snowman and let dry.

Fun! Facts! Winter "Wonder" Land

- Did you know that all snowflakes have 6 sides?
