- Assorted decorative embellishments: stickers, gems, etc (whatever you have on hand)
- Optional supplies for Week 1 craft: basic first aid supplies – adhesive bandages (band aids), individually packed hand sanitizing wipes and first aid ointment packs

NOTE: Check each craft kit for specific supply needs.

AGE GROUP: 6 and up
PROJECT TIME: 30-45 minutes per craft

NOTE FOR INSTRUCTOR: This is a craft program designed for 8 weeks of summer camp. This program pack includes: 8 specific craft "program time" activities (each a minimum of 30 minutes), which make 48 projects each. One activity is a collaborative group project. Three "low mess" craft activities can be used during "before-camp" or "pick-up" of campers. All crafts are suitable for ages 6-10+ years old. Over 520 projects! The following is a suggested program guide. Feel free to move the projects around to suit your specific camp needs. Refer to the specific kits instructions as needed. Color-Me items do not come with instructions, use the recommended supplies (included in this pack), or use your own supplies.

PROGRAM GUIDE:

Week 1 Craft: Color-Me Waterproof Bag to make Basic First Aid Packs (makes 48)

Why: Start the summer with a useful craft while talking about safety!

Helpful to know: Use the permanent markers to decorate. The finished pack can attach to a belt loop or backpack when completed!

Prep time: Minimal. Either ask campers to donate the optional supplies or have camp supply, if possible.

Mess Scale: Low – permanent makers need to be used with care as they can stain hands and clothes.

Craft Encourages: Discussion about the importance of basic first aid, handwashing, and more.

Week 2 Craft: Patriotic Wood Pins Craft Kit (makes 48)

Why: 4th of July Celebration!

Helpful to know: Younger campers may need assistance with attaching the pinback.

Prep time: Minimal. See specific kit instructions.

Mess Scale: Medium. Uses acrylic paints.

Craft Encourages: This is a great opportunity to talk about patriotism, citizenship, the flag, red/white/blue, fireworks, independence, and freedom. Pins can be attached to hats, shirts, backpacks, and more!

Week 3 Craft: Animal Masks Craft Kit (makes 48)

Why: Great for a themed week – you can decorate however you want!

Helpful to know: Use the included markers and add your own foam stickers, adhesive gems, feathers, and more!

Prep time: Minimal. Just pull together your own decorating supplies.

Mess Scale: Low to medium.

Craft Encourages: Imaginary play as part of a themed costume week or skits.

Week 4 Craft: Paint Palette: Always Be Yourself Craft Kit (makes 48)

Why: Great for discussions about being true to yourself.

Helpful to know: You need a flat surface for painting.

Prep time: None.

Mess Scale: Low.

Craft Encourages: Discussions, confidence building, and more.

Week 5 Craft: Sunflower Sticker Mosaic Craft Kit (makes 1)

Why: This is a great collaborative project which can be created over time.

Helpful to know: You need to attach to a wall with strong tape or tacks. Part collaborative and part puzzle! We recommend calling this a Mystery Art project and campers build it to solve what the picture is!

Prep time: Minimal.

Mess Scale: Low.

Craft Encourages: Collaboration!

Week 6 Craft: Code a Keychain Craft Kit (makes 48)

Why: Great for a STEM week!

Helpful to know: Instruction guide is full of coding related information to extend learning!

Prep time: Low.

Mess Scale: Low.

Craft Encourages: Computer coding discussions.

Week 7 Craft: Silly Stones Craft Kit (makes 48)

Why: Make Silly Stones or Kindness rocks to share!

Helpful to know: You need outdoor sealant if stones are going to be displayed outside.

Prep time: Low.

Mess Scale: Medium. Kit has acrylic paint.

Craft Encourages: Kindness Rocks, garden theme, and imaginary play.

Week 8 Craft: Color-Me Flower Pots (makes 48)

Why: Time to wrap up summer camp with a take home flower pot.

Helpful to know: You need to supply the soil and seeds or just have the kids decorate the pot. Use the permanent and the all-purpose markers to decorate and whatever supplies you have on hand!

Prep time: Low.

Mess Scale: Low if just decorating the pot.

Craft Encourages: Memory making (which is what camp is all about!).

“Before-Camp” and “Pick-Up Time” Activities (each activity makes 48 projects)

- Buddy the Dinosaur Craft Kit
- Color-Me™ Star Stringers
- Paint-A-Dot™ Camp Fun Craft Kit

Why: These 3 kits are great to have for easy crafting during drop off/pick up times. Activities during this time can help with a kid's transition to/from camp.

Helpful to know: Use the all-purpose markers for Buddy and the Stars.

Prep time: Minimal.

Mess Scale: Low.

Craft Encourages: Imagination! Create and play with the Dinosaurs, decorate your camp with the Star Stringers and create a take home memory with the Camp Fun Card.

Fun Facts! Random Acts of Kindness Challenge:

Can you do a small act of kindness each day for a week? It could be as small as opening and holding a door, smiling and saying good morning, or helping (without being asked) around your house. What can you do in your corner of the world to make it a better place for others?
