**Preparation Instructions:**

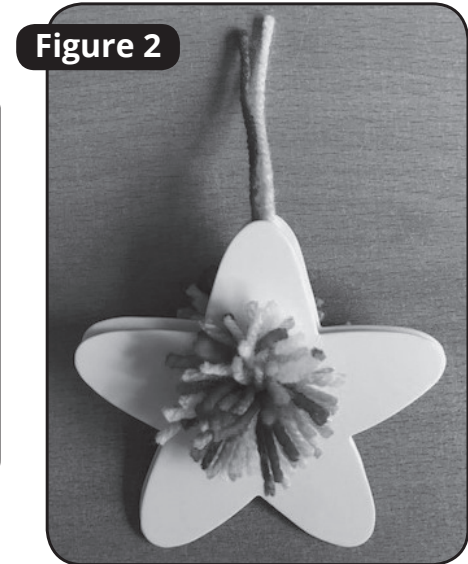
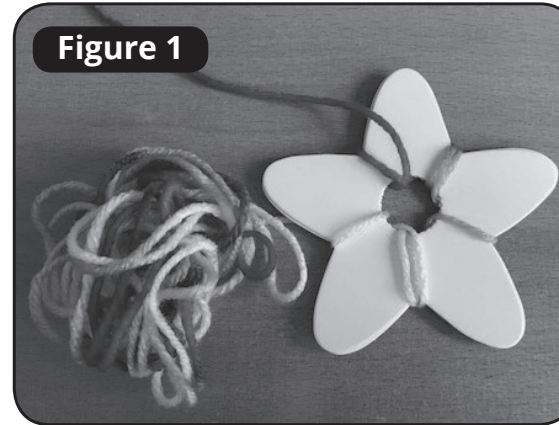
Cut 24 pieces of the yarn, each 15 feet long. Roll each piece into a loose ball leaving about a 6" piece loose at 1 end.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Decorate your 2 star shapes however you want. You can also add some decorations after making the pom pom.
2. Match the 2 star shape pieces together so the center holes line up.

**TIP:** To prevent the yarn from knotting, cut it into shorter lengths to make wrapping easier. As you finish wrapping 1 piece, just tie on another length and keep wrapping around/through star.

3. Take the ball of yarn and starting at the 6" end, push the ball through the center hole of both stars. The 6" piece should be loose and then start wrapping the yarn through the center hole and the outside of the star shape (see Figure 1).
4. Keep wrapping the yarn until you have about 10" left.
5. Take your scissors and carefully slide in between the 2 star shapes and start to cut the wrapped yarn. Hold the star together as you cut around the shape.
6. Take 1 of the ends of yarn, between the 2 star shapes wrap it around the yarn and pull tight. Leave some yarn hanging out
7. See Figure 2. Take the other yarn end and repeat step 5.
8. Take the 2 ends of the yarn and tie them together to make a hanging loop.
9. Use the scissors to shape the pom pom if you want.
