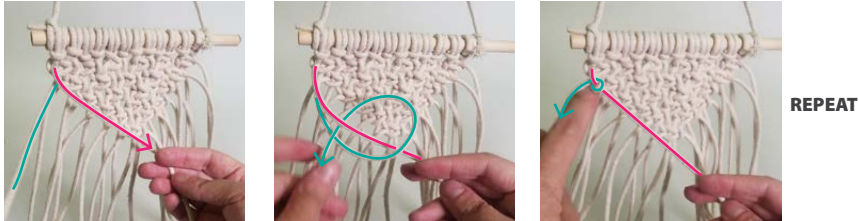


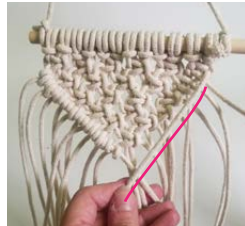
STEP 5: FINISHING SLIP KNOTS

Use this step for both left and right sides

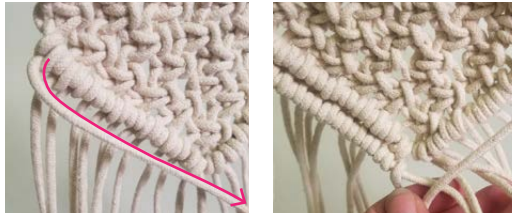
Take the first outer cord on the left (the lead cord) and hold it so it follows the diagonal line of the finished knots. Use the second cord and loop it over the lead cord and slide it up to the top of the lead cord. Repeat this step again with the same 2 cords (you wrap it twice)



Still working off of the lead cord, take the next cord down and repeat the double looping steps. Continue doing this for each cord on the left side until you have one row of looped knots all the way down. Repeat these steps on the right side.



Repeat step 5 again on both sides, you will end up with two rows of loops down each side of your piece, like shown here.



STEP 6: FINISHING TOUCHES

Add beads to your hanging cords and knots at each end to keep the beads from falling off. Add a hanging cord at the top tied to the two ends of your dowel rod.

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STEP 1: THREADING CORD ONTO THE DOWEL ROD

First fold one piece of cord in half. Wrap the center fold of your cord over the dowel rod and tuck bottom of cords through the loop and pull tight.



Repeat this step for each of the 12 cords

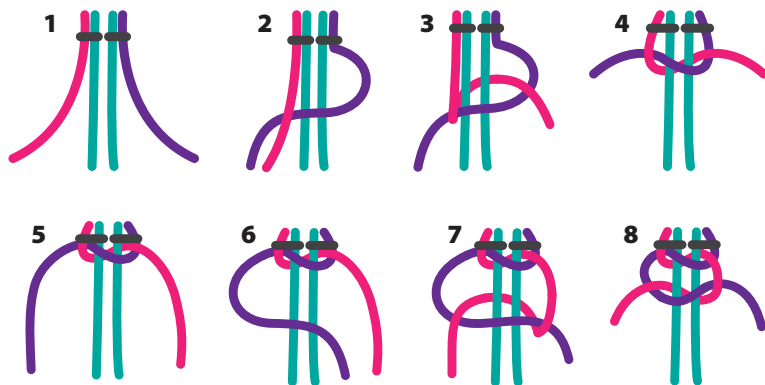
STEP 2: SQUARE KNOT ROW 1

Keep in mind rows of knots are worked from left to right

Starting with the far left hanging cord take the first 4 cords on the left and make a Right handed knot (follow the diagrams). Next, using the same 4 cords, make a Left handed knot, shown in these diagrams.

Pull your knot tight to make a Full Square Knot

Continue making Full Square Knots across all of your cords, moving from left to right. You will end up with 6 full knots.



STEP 3: SQUARE KNOT ROW 2

For the second row of knots, skip the first two and last two cords in the row. They will be used later. Starting with the second and third cords, make Full Square Knots across your cords from left to right. You will make 5 complete knots in this row.

Pull your cords tight as you work!

Make sure you leave the last two cords loose in this row!



STEP 4: SQUARE KNOT ROWS 3-6

At this point of the process you will be repeating step 3 for each row until the design comes to a point or "V" shape. Make sure you separate the two cords on the left and right in each row while you work. Your macrame should now have 6 knots in row 1, 5 knots in row 2, 4 knots in row 3, 3 knots in row 4, 2 knots in row 5, 1 knot in row 6.
