- 2. Using the glass stain tubes, carefully squeeze the color you'd like for a section of the pin. Use the toothpicks to carefully move the stain into the corners of the pin section and pop any air bubbles. Use toothpicks to pick up small drops of the glass stain off the paper plate and add to your design if you want.
- 3. Carry the finished design on the scrap paper, to an undisturbed spot and let dry.

**Note:** The drying time of the glass stain varies depending on how thickly it is applied. We recommend allowing 2 hours for drying.

4. Peel and stick 1 side of the adhesive foam across the flat side of the pin back. Peel and stick the other side of the foam to the back of your pin, carefully pressing it into place.
